It's common and expected to experience sexual health side effects as a result of your cancer or its treatment. Some side effects are temporary and others can be persistent and long lasting. These issues are health care issues and we want you to bring them to our attention immediately.

Though you may not care about your sexual health right now, studies show addressing these issues sooner vs later increase the chances of having them resolved. If a member of your care team hasn't addressed the possible impact your cancer or its treatment will have on your sexual health, please ask me any of the following:

1. How will my specific treatment affect my sexual health?
2. What are the common side effects of my specific treatment?
3. When will sexual health side effects begin and how will they last?
4. Is there anything I can do to lessen the severity of the side effects?
5. Are there alternative treatments that could preserve my sexual health?
6. Is there anything I should be doing or reading to prepare me for the potential side effects?

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
